

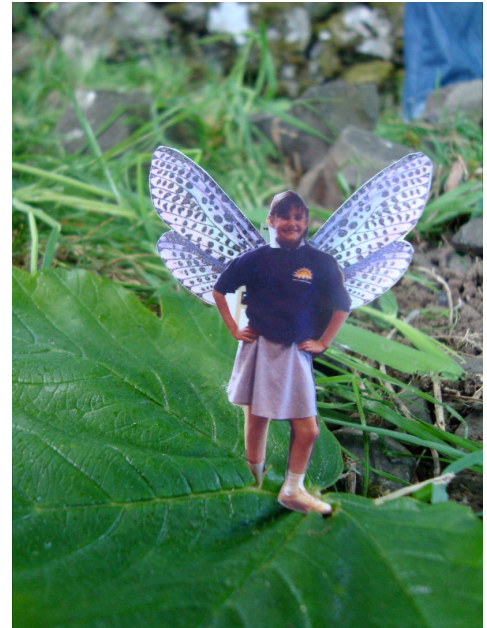
North Lakes School Assertive Mentoring

Apply rewards and sanctions at home to support the Assertive Mentoring approach?
